IFI Accredited fitness equipment must meet IFI Equipment Design Standards to be fully inclusive, enabling both disabled and non-disabled people to benefit from a full body, cardiovascular and resistance-based workout.

The IFI Equipment Standards form part of the IFI Mark assessment and facilities must meet minimum standards within their fitness equipment range to gain the accreditation.

As a result of the R&D work there is increased choice of accessible fitness equipment suppliers and their products within the market for leisure operators to choose from. The R&D partnership also supports product innovation amongst fitness equipment suppliers and fair competition for product sales and increased choice of accessible product range for IFI Mark facilities.
